ABSTRACT :

The S.S.A's Arts and Commerce college is established and administered by the religious and linguistic minority in Solapur . more than 98% student in the college belongs to minority and are from poor economic and educational background. The college under study is the only old and minority degree college in Solapur. It is the need of the time and community to educate the new generation and bring them into mainstream. College should be the place to understand their needs and problem, and need and work in that direction. Young generation boys and girls are the source and capital of the community, this Human Resource must be pushed for higher education bey creating the healthy, free and frank environment.

Admission process, induction to the college, clean and healthy infrastructure of the college, academic excellency of the teachers, library service, gymkhana, NCC,NSS, and cultural activities are the means for the all-round development. This human resource should be protected with rules of discipline, anti-ragging committee, grievance redress committee etc. This human resource should be connected with the community through extension work, learning with community service can make the responsible citizen. Finally the ultimate aim of the education is employment, profession or business, college can invite companies for campus selection, can have competitive exam guidance cell and can give profession training and skill development training to the student. Collins & G.)HR departments are responsible for overseeing employee-benefits design, employee recruitment, training and development, performance appraisal, and reward management, such as managing pay and employee benefits systems. Pauwe, J., & Boon, C. (2009). Strategic HRM: A critical review. JI HR also concerns itself with organizational change and industrial relations, or the balancing of organizational practices with requirements arising from collective bargaining and governmental laws

The overall purpose of human resources (HR) is to ensure that the organization can achieve success through people.(*Armstrong, Michael (2009). Armstrong's handbook of human resource management practice. Armstrong, Michael, 1928- (Eleventh ed.). London: Kogan)* HR professionals manage the human capital of an organization and focus on implementing policies and processes. They can specialize in finding, recruiting, selecting, training, and developing employees, as well as maintaining employee relations or benefits.

"Human capital management" (HCM) is sometimes used synonymously with "HR", although "human capital" typically refers to a narrower view of human resources; i.e. the knowledge the individuals embody and can contribute to an organization. Other terms sometimes used to describe the HRM field include "organizational management", "manpower management", "talent management", "personnel management", "workforce management", and simply "people management".

Griffin (1997), defined human resource management as the set of organizational activities directed at attracting, developing and maintaining an effective workforce. Human resource management concerns the procurement or recruitment, staffing, welfare, maintenance, training and retraining, placement, promotion, motivation relationship, compensation or rewards, transfer and discipline of staff. It lies at the care of the efficiency of the organization.

2. HUMAN RESOURCES MANAGEMENT IN COLLEGES:

The need to apply Human resources management in educational institution is utterly needed today . as we are going through the age of science, technology, individualism, liberty and radical changes hence Human resources in colleges are plenty to work upon. It very important to effectively manage the new generation of students . This is where HR management and practices plays an important role. Human resources management can help in increasing student performance, creativity, student involvement in all activities and good relation between teachers and student . This happens due to the involvement and motivation of the teachers. Furthermore, human resource management also tries to make teachers more efficient. Efficient teachers help in better development of students.Attention is also given hiring and retaining the best principal and Human Resource managers and personnel officers These people are responsible for the administration, training and development

of students in the college. So an efficient human resource management system would mean an efficient administration.

Any problems between students, student and teachers, student and policies of the government are readily met due to human resources management. Proper training of teachers happens due to HRM. Management of Human Resources pays attention to any short-comings of students. The HR team identifies the reason for this. Once identified, trained teachers can then handle the problem.

The paper provides a detailed account of a comprehensive HRM college model, codified by Doug Lemov (2015) and Paul Bambrick-Santoyo (2012), which incorporates students through an intensivelymanaged, top-down 'student culture'. Their work on student culture, a well-established concept endorsed by Ofsted (2016), is a particularly fully-developed, clearly-articulated example of the corporatised position of the student in the contemporary school. It is also a model that possesses significant international influence.

HRM includes:

- Recruiting new Admissions
- Evaluating student performance
- > Ensuring fair compensation and benefits through statutory and non statutory committees
- Training student for supporting education, sports, cultural activities, community service and development
- > Protecting the health and safety of all students through safe infra and sanitation

Human resource management in education is a set of practices and methods of integrating and maintaining the students boys and girls plus teaching and other staff in the institution or college so that the institution or school can achieve its purpose as well as meet the goals for which they were established. It is the motivation and coordination of the activities and efforts of teachers and other employees in college in order to obtain maximum output and consequently achieve the goals of education optimally. In other words human resource management is the process of motivating workers students, teachers and allied staff in the organization so as to obtain maximum output from them.A large body of research has identified that institutionalization of a strong human resource department could lead to improved organizational outcomes. If organizations want to develop a competitive advantage, they must have "the ability to acquire and effectively utilize human resources" (Guest & Clinton, 2007, p.4).

3. THE S.S.A'S ARTS AND COMMERCE COLLEGE:

The present study deals with the student respondents in degree level of the S.S.A's Arts and commerce college, Solapur. The invigilator is intending to investigate the Human Resource Management policies and practices being applied to shape the human resource mainly students towards the desired goal and to what extend the personnel practices are active for education, research, innovation, safety, sanity, security, discipline, liberty and all-round development of the student. The Sholapur Social Association's Arts and Commerce College is established and being administered by the religious (Muslim) and linguistic (Urdu) minority in the city hence the college has assigned minority status by the State government The S.S.A's Arts and Commerce college is situated in the heart of the city mainly the old Solapur thickly populated by the Muslim community. Solapur is the city of Maharashtra situated at the border of Maharashtra, Karnataka and Andhra Pradesh; population in Solapur including Muslims are mainly from these three states. The main occupation of people in the city is beed irolling, spinning of cotton, power-loom, wet processing, two wheel garages, steel fabrication, paramedical staff in hospitals, transportation, tea stalls, small shoppers, fruit and vegetable sellers, construction sector and very few in government and semi government jobs and government aided and unaided educational institutions. The present educated and uneducated generation is emigrated to Pune, Mumbai, Hyderabad, Bangalore and other metro cities for jobs. The city has 14 traditional degree colleges, 04 Engineering colleges, 02 Medical colleges, 02 Pharmacy colleges, 02 Paramedical college, 04 college of education 02 Law colleges. The college under study is at the 4th number in seniority list of the colleges.

With a noble intention to give Higher Education to the Muslims and other communities of Solapur and surrounding; the traders, businessman and educated men of Muslim community established The S.S.A's Arts and Commerce college in the year 1978. it is the fourth college in the city situated at the heart of the town surrounded by Muslim population. The college has its own building situated at Sidheshwar Peth Solapur, admeasuring 2300 square meter i.e. 02 acre land with Survey No. 10659. half portion of the land is used for the construction for class room, library, offices, lab and auditorium and remaining is for the playing ground for basket ball, volleyball and parking lot. The parents of these students are employed, self employed, professional, owners, artisans and workers in the above occupations, as their earnings are meager they cannot afford to pay tuition fees, books, uniform and other expenses.

Eligibility: student clearing std.XII from any stream are admitted to degree classes, besides this diploma in education and engineering too are enrolled. Graduates of any faculty are admitted to Post Graduation in Urdu. Admission for Ph.D. are as per the norms of the University. As the Institute is Religious and Linguistic minority hence reservation quota for admission is not applicable

Indicators of Human Resource Management: Students are the Human Resource, this resource is to shape and mobilize for personal and social development in all respects; the college through its academic curriculum, extracurricular and extension work is trying to galvanize them through Human Resource policies and practices. The college has statutory and non-statutory committees working for and with the students The Admission Committee, the Examination and Evaluation Committee, the Discipline Committee, Anti-Ragging Committee, Internal Complaint Committee, Student Council, National Cadet Corp, National Service Scheme, Career Guidance Cell, Placement Cell, Minority cell, Special Cell, Grievances Cell, Library Committee, and Cultural Pogramme committee etc. these committees are student-centric and for their democratic participation in academic activities and other committees.

The faculty in the college is qualified, all of them have acquired Master Degree and Research Degree in their respective subject, many of them have cracked qualifying examination SET and NET. Every faculty in the college has written Research Papers and got published in reputed national and international research journals, some of them have edited books, some have authored the text books and reference books. The faculties in the college are members of the Board of Studies, Chairman Board of studies and Dean of the stream, member of academic council and research committee. The Director of Physical Education in the college is the best coach and member of selection committee for University

and State hockey and football team, he is the coordinator and organizer of sports events of the University.

5. SCOPE OF THE STUDY:

The scope of the study covers every personnel and aspect of the college contributing for the management of the human (student) resources. 1] Right from the admission process, counselling of the student for choosing subject, scholarship, medium of learning.2] the physical amenities in the college too matters, they are also to be covered like parking, spacious class room, lavatories, drinking water, sitting plot, canteen, gym and space for yoga etc.3] All the department contributing their best for the management and development human energies; department of Urdu, Geography, English , Commerce and Management, School of Social Sciences, Library, Computer Lab. 6. MATERIALS AND METHODS:

Human Resource Management in education: Issues and Challenges. *A case study of SSA's Arts and Commerce College, Solapur.* It is a case study of an educational institute in management of human resources. Student are the respondent resources and the entire structure and functions of the college involved in management and development of the student, the historical background, geographical location and category student admitted in the college are under study.

6.1 Data Collection and Study Design:

it is decided to stratify the student respondents into Arts and Commerce stream and equal proportion of sample is decided to collect from each stream, the questionnaire containing the questions on the subject is decided to mail or what app the student, the fact is that, commerce student are more regular and have the knowledge to handle the electronic device like whats app and email hence they are ahead in responding us, few Arts student were dormant hence commerce respondents are replaced.

6.3. Questionnaire Design:


It is difficult to interview all the respondent during the teaching hours, hence it is decided to frame the questionnaire containing the questions of the subject. A Google form of questionnaire is prepared it is mail and What app to the student respondents of both the stream morever a QR code containing the questionnaire is created and placed at the notice board of the college so as to capture the respondents. The questionnaire contains 86 questions pertaining to admission, physical facilities in the college, contribution of various departments, role of the library, student evaluation process, statutory and non-statutory committees in the college, student participation in various committees, Extra curricular activities, sports NCC, NSS, and community service etc are included in to record the responses of the respondents.

6.4.Ethical Consideration:

It is the case study of the Human Resource Management in S.S.A's Arts and Commerce college hence care is taken to follow the ethics of investigation, dignity, liberty and freedom of the nonresidents are to be respected. A pilot study of the Five respondent is conducted to see if the respondents are free to reply. Respondents are given freedom to fill-up the questionnaire at home without obligation, secrecy of the responses is maintained so that the respondent must not be exposed.

6.5. Statistical Analysis:



The college admission chart for the Academic Year is Male =553 and Female=333 Total=886



Stream wise Representation of the Respondents



Year of Enrollment in the College



Source or Base of Admission



6] Did admission committee help you to fill admission form ?




Admission Committee


office work


Freedom to chose the subject


Transparency of Admission

Fees for admission



Category of the student



Bu the student admitted in the college hails from such background all are given their due status and facilities. 38.8% student are from good economic background hence they are paying tuition fees, 36.3% are from Economically Backward Class. Their EBC status is certified by the competent authority and they are awarded concession in fees. 23.8% belongs to Other Backward Class category (OBC) their status is verified by the government authorities and are awarded scholarships, only 1% student belongs to SC/ST category, their status is verified by the government and are given their due right. Induction Programme




Induction Programme





Induction with other departments




Student Relation and Interaction

Teacher Student Relations



Information of Scholarships



Teaching and learning




Medium of Instruction


Attendance in the class


Teachers attendance in the class

Teacher's Subject Knowledge



Teaching of Syllabi




Knowledge Sources


Syllabus Completion



Student - Teacher Relations




Library Services


Number of Books in the Library


Extra Reading in the Lib.


Use of Lib. infrastructure

Working hours of the library.



Student's satisfaction with Lib. services




Guidance for Exams

Evaluation of the student by the University




Promotion of the student in the next class

Revaluation of exam papers






Extra Curricular activities







Sports Team








Necessity of extra-curricular activities


Vending Machine






Scholarship for Girls


Working hours of the college


WiFi facility in the college







Student in the college are motivated by the politics. There are student groups and organization they are not registered . 55% student say that they have union while 45% say there is no student union in the college




Student Council


Student Participation in decision making

7. CONCLUSIONS:

To record the responses of the respondent on the subject the investigator created the Google form and send to the target respondent, in all 80 respondent filled the form and send to the investigating team, the responses were recorded in the form of graph and pie chart; after analyzing the responses the researcher is attempting to draw conclusions.

Personal information: The Google form questionnaire contain the name of the respondent, as part of research ethic their names are kept hidden. Out of total sampled respondents(80 respondents) Females constitute 55% and Male respondents constitutes 45%. Female respondents are ahead to attend the Questionnaire where as the males are reluctant. The reason is females are regular to the college and are more sincere towards assignment of the college and they. Further it is reported that, out of total 80 respondents 60% of them are from Arts faculty or Humanities and 40% of them are from Commerce and Management stream. The students from the Arts stream are more open to respond the questionnaire.

Admissions: When we searched the year of admission of the student it is found that, 50% of them have enrolled in the year 2022-2023. the student in the latest year are ahead to record their responses; these students have experienced academic and extracurricular activities in the college. More than 50% student have got admission on the basis of merit, after merit list is completed and the seats are vacant then other eligible candidates are admitted, some times after the closure of admission one or admission are given under influence of locals, the drive does not harm the rules of admission. Majority of the student say that, the admission committee help the student for getting admission, the committee is helping in filling the admission form, selection of subject, insurance guide for category of payment. The office staff is too prompt and efficient to get the student enroll in time. More than 73% student say that they are at liberty to choose NCC. NSS and Sports, respondents are voluntarily willingly taking part into extra curricular units, extra curricular activities must for the all round development of the students. More than 80 student say that, the admission process is transparent. The admission committee and office staff on their part are transparent. The fees charged to the student is as per norms hence 86.3% student are satisfied by saying that, fees to them is according to the University norms. admission committee display the fees chart at admission counter open to see and comment. The chart is as per the structure given by the university. Student admitted in the college are from diverse economic and caste background. Religion, caste and Economic status is not the base of admission. The student admitted in the college hails from such background all are given their due status and facilities. student belongs to SC/ST category, their status is verified by the government and are given their due right. Our college is strictly not for the minority students, it is opened for the students of all religions, castes and categories. **Induction Programme:** It is the practice and culture of the college that, the newly admitted student are inducted with the infra and working of the college, at the first day of the college the teachers in their respective class introduces themselves, their subject, library, gymkhana, office, scholarships, extracurricular activities and civic amenities in the college. Even the student themselves too introduce themselves to the staff and their class mates. 50% student say that they are inducted with the college while 50% don't know about the induction programme it is because of absenteeism or late admission in the college. Induction programme makes the student feel free and comfortable and they are acquainted with the college and their classmates; healthy relation can be established. Boys and girls have separate civic amenities like drinking water, urinals, parking and sitting arrangements.

The college and teachers not only introduces with the syllabi and subjects but also introduces with gymkhana, library, NCC, NSS, Office, youth festival, Avishkar etc. Such activities are also necessary for the all round development of the student. 63.7% students says that they are introduced all components in the college Students are ignorant of college building floor plan, class room , departments etc such students are escorted escorted by the peons or sometimes by the teachers. 70% students say that, they are escorted to the respective classroom and department Student in all classes are in contact and friendly relation with each-other, friendly and healthy environment in classroom and premises is necessary for learning and extracurricular activities. 55% student say that, they know the names of their classmates.

As part of induction and to to give personal attention and better education is the aim of the institution. Students are expected to know the names of their teachers and their educational qualification.

Scholarship to monitory help the needy student to bear the expenses of education. The college has the provision OBC scholarship, EBC facility, Minority scholarship, of Poor Boys Fund and Social Kanya scheme to give financial support to the student.

Teaching and Learning: As the college is established and managed by the religious and linguistic minority community, it has liberty to chose the language of instruction. The college adapted English and Marathi as medium of teaching, Urdu as one of the compulsory and optional subject at Humanities and commerce. Urdu is being taught at Post Graduate level. 60% student have preferred English as medium of learning, 13% have preferred Marathi medium and 26% student have offered Urdu as optional subject at Degree level and Post Graduate level The college is regular and run in day time' lecture method and PPT method is adapted for teaching. Students are bound to attend the class for lecture and Home Assignments. In response to the question on attendance 82.5% student says that they are regular in the class Teacher in the college is an important ingredient for teaching, tutorials, discussion, tutorials and tutorials. His in-time presence in the class is necessary for everything. 75% student says that their teacher timely attend the class.

Teacher in the senior college must be qualified, studied, and must have ample subject knowledge to communicate his knowledge, perceptions before the student. A studied teacher can control the class and galvanize his student. Pertaining to teacher's subject knowledge 75% student say that, they are satisfied with the subject knowledge of their teacher.

Any teacher before entering into class prepare himself with books and current affairs, a good teacher never diverts from the subject, he communicate and present the subject by keeping in view the nature and scope of the subject this attitude can give specific subject knowledge and student can secure good marks. 65% student says that, their teacher teaches within the frame line of the university syllabus.

Besides teaching in the class room, referring the prescribed text books for studies the teachers in the college snuggest the student to refer other sources of knowledge like reference books, journals and projects on the subject. 52.5% student say that, their teacher suggest them to refer other sources of knowledge.

To teach within the content of the syllabus and that to finish before the examination is duty of every subject teacher. Near about all the teachers are particular in carry to finish their curriculum before the examination. 66.3% student say that their subject teachers finishes the syllabus before the time.

Healthy Human Resource Management and better organizational relations requires the healthy and cooperative relation between the two ends involve in. In industries and college healthy relation between employer and worker, teacher and student are must. In the college under study 43.8% student says that, they have academic relation with their teacher.

Libraries are the Sources of Knowledge, a rich library can serve ocean of knowledge to the teachers and students. Having a rich collection of books is part of pride and guarantee of knowledge. Student and teacher regularly visits the library for the transaction of books, journals, magazines, news papers, encyclopedia, dictionaries, E-books and E-journals too. 60% student regularly goes to library.

Any library is known for the books it has, Reference books, Text Books, Subject dictionaries, Encyclopedia, Magazines, Journals, Project reports, News papers etc are the content of library collection. The study material must meet the demand the students, there should be coordination between demand and supply. For the college library under study.

Education doesn't mean referring only text book and class room teaching, besides prescribed syllabi one has to refer interdisciplinary books, reference books, encyclopedia, journals, magazines, news papers, e-books, e-journals, and educational DCs this could give you an ample knowledge for university examinations, commutative-exams and can develop a confidence in the student.

Library is knowledge resource centre having thousands of books, with supportive Encyclopedia, Dictionaries, Journals, research papers E-books and journals, news papers etc. Betides the academic material the library has infrastructure facilities like chairs, tables, fans, drinking water, computer and printer student sits in the library for studies majority of the student are availing infrastructure facilities. 56.3% student say that they are availing the library facilities. it is obvious that, library is the knowledge resource centre, students are abound sit in the library for studies; the library remain open between 8.00 a.m to 6.00pm every day. Student are availing the library books and infrastructure.

The library staff is in the service of student for Library transaction and study infrastructure; attitude and services of the library staff can attract the student and maintain healthy relations. 46% students say that, they have working relations with the lib. Staff.

Evaluation and Promotion of the Students:

It is necessary to evaluate what student have learned. There are several methods of evaluation like University examinations, oral test, project work, home assignment, tutorials etc. The college is applying Home Assignment method to evaluate the knowledge of the student. 78.8% student say that, Home Assignment is the method to evaluate the student learning.

After teaching, learning and examination students are evaluated to measure their ability, the result reflect the work of teacher also. Majority of the student say that, they are evaluated, Home Assignment is the method of evaluation. Reliability of evaluation process must be transparent and reliable. 75% student say that the evaluation process is Impartial and transparent.

The University conducts two examinations in one academic year rules of the examinations, fees and dates are send to the college; it is the responsibility of the college to communicate same to the student 58.8% student say that, the college teacher and office guide them for the extermination.

Students are evaluated twice in one academic year, the method of overvaluation is University Examination. All theory papers are assessed by the panel of the examiners appointed by the University authorities.

Student cracking the university examination must be promoted into the next class. Theory paper and evaluation of paper are the means of evaluation, after evaluation result it is decided to promote or detain.

Personality Development Programmes:

Besides academic academic work teaching learning and examinations, the extracurricular activities too are important for the all-round development of the student. Extracurricular includes NCC,NSS Sports, Youth festival, Avishkar, cultural programme in the college. The college generally issue a notice inviting the student to participate in extracurricular events. 75% student say that, college is giving equal opportunities to all to participate in extracurricular acclivities.

NSS: National Service Scheme is one of the best extracurricular activity, it connect the college student to the community, community work through learning. The college has two NSS units admitting 200 volunteers. All programmes directed by university and government are observed in the college and in community. Some of the activities are <u>International Yoga Day</u>, Shiva Rajabhishek Day Ceremony,Tree Plantation Programme,Organ donation day, Seminar on International Literacy Day,Mahatma Gandhi Birth Anniversary.Reading Inspiration Day, National Unity Day and Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel Birth AnniversaryWorld Human Rights Day,National Education Day, COVID-19 vaccination, Constitution DayMinority Rights Day, Blood donation camp completed in Social, Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav celebrated in Social College,My Vasundhara oath, Faculty were present.Savitribai Phule Jayanti and Balika Din Youth Day, National Voting Day, Health check-up campInternational Women's Day, Special Camp at adapted Village

NCC : The college has National Cadet Corp (N.C.C.) affiliated to 9 MAH BN NCC Solapur

Both male and fe male students are the NCC candidates in our college. We recruit the NCC cadets through physical fitness and written examination. It's a two year programme for *B* and *C* certificate. Our cadets have attended the Army attachment camp also. The regular activities are parade on every Sunday, Independence Day and Republic Day parade, participation in college extracurricular activities. Cadets attended the Camp H.D.College Solapur Unity, discipline is the motto of the NCC. The training is necessary to train the student for discipline, uptodateness, obedience to law and order and helping the public in times of crisis.our major activities are , NCC Day Celebration ,Blood Donation camp ,Republic Day parade, and Tree Plantation Swatch Bharat Abhiyan , Combine Annual Training Camp at Soalpur. Development of leadership qualities, dignity, self-confidence, nationalism, patriotism various types of social service activities undertaken for NCC cadets through.

Sports : The college is known for its sports achievement in Hockey and Football, besides these two specialty the gymkhana has volleyball, basket ball, table tennis, cricket wrestling, boxing, weight lifting, judo, high jump and long jump. Students of all classes are informed to participate in sports. The director of physical education is the selector of the player, the elected team members are coached regularly and are enrolled for all levels of sport tournaments physical education, fitness sports is an essential activity to carryout group event, to, to chase success and to develop spirit of sportsmanship.

Cultural Events Education, art, skill, singing, painting, writing, oratory, dance and music are the elements of culture. The college arranges cultural programmes to encourage the student to develop their skill, ability, creativity, and artistic presentation. Students are encourage to participate in college level cultural events, Youth festival and Avishkar. The cultural programme committee guide and encourage the ability in the student to profess and present the at in them.

Statutory Welfare Facilities:

Getting satisfied with toilet needs with respect is the basic need and human rights of the students. The college has a provision of toilets and urinals for the student, the number of both the units

are sufficient in number. 68.8% student say that, the number of toilets and urinals are sufficient Of the total strength of the college near about half of the students are girls, these adolescent girls goes through the menstruation. The college is bound to place a vending machine to get the sanitary napkin and to burn the used one Safe drinking water in the college premises is the right of student, sufficient drinking water in all departments, office and common place in the college is necessary and is made available at reachable places.

The college and its all departments including library and class room must be safe in all respect. As per the norms of the commercial public institution there must be Fire Extinguishing weapon in library and other places.

Female students are also more in number on the college roll to encourage them for higher education and to give financial the government has introduced scholarship for girls like Begum Hazrat mahal scholarship, Maulana Azad minority scholarship; student eligible for the scholarship are availing it.

The admissions of the college are open for all, only 1% student belongs to SC/ST category, such student too can avail the government scholarship.

Student's life matters be it a boy or girl or from any category, every student enrolling in the college is ensured. The LIC form is attached with the admission form hence it is binding to fill the LIC for. The tenure of the policy is one academic year only, every year a new form is filled.

College is an institution where in 800 students comes for education and extracurricular activities. It is bound to have First Aid Box in the college to give first aid to the injured student.

Health of the student matters, it is necessary to check the health of the student with intervals, the college is in MOU with Family Planning Association of India to arrange the camp. HB checkup camp, teeth checkup camp are conducted, the college under its NSS activities arranges health checkup camp at adapted village.

Non-Statutory Welfare Facilities:

- Student enrolled in the college comes by motor cycle and bicycles, it is on the college to make the provision of parking for the student in premises and adjacent ground
- ▶ It is obligatory on every educational institution to plant and maintain greenery in the college premises. Green and clean premises is to maintain.
- Student and stake holder enter into college building through gate and premises, the peons and other personnel seep the yard and keep the premises clean.
- A canteen or refreshment centre is necessary in the college premises, the canteen is run by one of the student. The college starts at 7-30 a.m and continued upto 12-30, boys and girls staying for six hour in the college go to canteen for tea, and breakfast
- The boys and girls and girls in off lecture and leisure hours sits at the plat-form; boys and girls have separate platform to sit and discuss on the syllabic and other issues.
- Besides the academic education the college is particular on cultural activities for the student. Extracurricular activities helps to develop personality. NSS, singing, music, elocution, drama painting etc are the cultural activities. The college as an auditorium and an open space on the ground for.
- The college have provision of poor boys fund, student unable to pay admission fees, examination fees, unable to have dress code, or cannot afford to go for study tour is helped from the poor boys fund.
- Student enrolled in the college are mainly from the Solapur city, very few of them are from the adjacent villages. The college has no provision of hostel for any of them.

Standing Order of the college:

Standing order the set of norms and laws made the college management for administration and discipline, such standing order never hurt the University Act and UGC recommendations. Our college too have standing order as rules of discipline.

- As part of rules of discipline all the student boys and girls are bound to be in college dress code or uniform for entering premises and class room. Dress code is compulsory for everyone.
- Possessing the Identity card is binding for every student; any student attending the class or in library, office, or in computer lab must possess his or her Identity card.
- The college is following the rules of discipline and boards of prevention on use of cell is placed on all floors
- The college premises is academic it is bound to be clean free from pollution and dirt. Spitting and smoking in the college premises is strictly prohibited, sign boards of prevention are placed on all floors
- The college starts at 7:30 in the morning and leaves at 1:15p.m daily, attendance in the classes is compulsory. Regarding the working hours of the college
- The college standing order and rules of discipline is binding for all, violation of rules is punished by fine or expulsion from the college,
- Use of cell phone is strictly prohibited in the college premises and class room; sign board of prohibition are placed in the college, rules of discipline are given to the student.
- As per the rules of discipline every student must come in uniform and must possess the identity card. Student without dress code uniform in the class are expelled, a student without Identity card is not entertained.
- The rules of discipline and anti ragging committee powers are acknowledge to the students; teasing the girls and harassing the boys and girls both are prohibited and punished
- Ragging of student in the college premises is strictly prohibited. The college has constituted the Anti-Ragging committee, names and cell numbers of the committee members are displayed, punishment for ragging is acknowledge to all.

Communication System:

- All the notices of the college and letters of the University are communicated to the student. The college as adapted methods like notice board, whats app and both for acknowledging the student.
- The college has installed wifi facilities for the student and teacher for communication, notices and search for knowledge.
- The college has installed two computer labs for the student one for girls and another for boys, each Lab constitute 10 computers. An instructor is called to train the student for computer skill

Unionism:

Student council in the college is constituted only by the order of the stat government. There are no student council in any college since Covid-19. 51.2% student say that, they have student council while 48.8% say that, they have no council at all Student are included into decision making process through Anti ragging committee, Internal Complaint Committee and discipline committee and National Cadet Corp; student through these committee are involved in the decision making process.

To maintain discipline in the college is the prime aim of the college, the college has constituted the discipline committee of teachers including boys and girls student and local police officers. The aim is the maintain discipline in the college and to act on the person violating the discipline.

The college has constituted Anti-ragging committee and Internal Complaint Committee both the committee are statutory and binding to form and act. Students are also included into both the committees.

Academic Excellence:

Suggestions:

Sholapur Social Association is a religious and linguistic minority educational institution established to give Higher Education to the student of minority and others. The college is located in midst of the city and surrounded by dense population. It is a co-educational, student enrolled in the

college are from Solapur city itself and mofassil majority of the student are from poor economic and educational background.

1] The college building is in the heart of the city and surrounded by dense population, the environment is filled with noise and pollution and there is no space to expand the college activities hence it is better if the building is away from the dense pollution with full space, free from noise and sound pollution.

2] The college building must be used only for graduate and post graduate classes, premises classes shared with Primary School and High School is causing noise and nuisance, damages to infrastructure and furniture.

3] College building should not be given for marriages, parties, political meets, religious meets and other organization not concerned with education.

4] As more than 800 student boys and girls are taking education in the college, it is need of the student to have a college canteen run by the student.

5] The management of the college should take initiative to make provision of Hostel for the rural students.

6] Management and teachers should implement Rules of discipline in the college to deal with incidents of ragging, nuisance, quarrel, teasing, spitting and indiscipline acts.

7] The subjects taught and departments in the college are as it were in 1984, being minority institute the college management can introduce new subjects, new departments and new streams like Science, pharmacy and law, engineering and medical.

8] As the college belongs to minority, it can avail the benefits of minority status by introducing Civil Services Exam coaching centre and library, skill development courses, physical training camp for recruitment in police and defence.

9] Minority student are under the wrong impression that, their candidature is denied in government and semi government jobs. Make arrangement of career guidance cell, job fare, campus interview etc

10] The college and its different units and department should be encourage to enter into MOU with other NGOs and colleges in the city to enhance quality of education and community service this attempt may popularize the college and can bring the student into mainstream.

11] Teachers should be encouraged for innovations, creativity, research and writing in their respective subject or in interdisciplinary area . Participation in seminar, conferences, workshop and academic meets must be encourage.

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
