



# ATTITUDE TOWARDS TEACHING AS A PROFESSION AMONG TEACHERS

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#### **ABSTRACT:**

The present research study based on the attitude of teachers towards teaching as a profession among the government and private teachers of Kalaburagi district. In this study the researcher tried to know the influence of working status on the attitude among the teachers, the attitude towards teaching as a profession in the educational institutes like, government and private high schools of Kalaburagi district. The major objectives of the study - to know the level of attitude towards teaching as a profession among the sample

groups. To compare the attitude between government and private high schools teachers of Kalaburagi district. The hypothesis of the study- there would be significance difference in attitude towards teaching as a profession among government and private teachers of the Kalaburagi district. There would be significance influence of working status on the attitude toward teaching as a profession among the government and private high school teachers. The sample of the study- the researcher selected one hundred secondary school teachers and made two equal groups of government and private teachers the attitude towards teaching as a profession measured through the standard scale Attitude Towards Teaching Profession by Kulsum (2001) is prepared for the training institutions not only for diagnostic and prognostic purposes, but also for finding out the attitudes of teachers working for them to change if required. The statistical techniques used – the mean, standard deviation and t tests were used to find out the result of the study.

Many psychologists have given different definitions for attitudes. According to Schneider (1988), 'Attitudes are evaluative reactions to persons, objects, and events. This includes your beliefs and positive and negative feelings about the attitude object. He also added that attitude can guide our experiences and decide the effects of experience on our behaviors.

**Allport** (1935, p.34) defines it as "a mental and neural state of readiness, organised through experience, exerting a directive or dynamic influence upon the individual's response to all objects and situations with which it is related."

**Thurstone** (1946, p. 39) has defined attitude as "the degree of positive or negative affect associated with some psychological object

#### **METHOD**

The present study deals with the very important aspect attitude among the teachers those are working in government and private secondary schools of Kalaburagi district. The researcher wanted to find out the influence of working status like, government and private status on the attitude towards teaching as a profession.

#### The Objectives

- > To know the level of attitude towards teaching as a profession among the sample groups.
- > To compare the attitude between government and private teachers of Kalaburagi district.
- ➤ To find out the significance influence of working status on the attitude towards teaching as a profession among the teachers.

#### The hypothesis of the study

- > There would be significance difference in attitude towards teaching as a profession among government and private secondary school teachers of the Kalaburagi district.
- > There would be influence of job status on the attitude towards teaching as a profession among teachers.

#### The sample of the study-

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
