So the hypothesis that is there no significant difference in risks taking behaviour of B.Ed students in relation to creativity is rejected.

CONCLUSION

- 1. There are significant differences between risk taking behaviour of B.Ed students having the high and low creativity. Therefore the hypothesis "there is no significant difference between risk taking behaviour B.Ed students having high and low creativity is rejected. This show that risk taking behaviour of B.Ed students in affected by their creativity. It means that B.Ed students with high creativity have high risk taking behaviour.
